

Mars vs Venus

A few years ago, a worldwide study called MALES (Men's Attitudes on Life Events and Sexuality) was launched to try to pinpoint the male perspective on life and sex.

The results are due to be released later this year. In the meantime a study called MALES 2 has been announced, and it will also determine women's views.

"So far we've found men consider their erection and sexual function a symbol of their masculinity," says Professor Marita McCabe, a clinical psychologist from Melbourne's Deakin University who's helping to design MALES 2.

"Women are more interested in the interpersonal aspects of sex. They are not so focused on the performance. Foreplay aspects of sex as well as intercourse are important to women."
